



A Step-by-Step Guide to Foster Care Ministry

Month 0:

Learn about the needs of local children in the foster care system Commit to being part of the solution

Seek approval from your administrative council

Month 1: Week 1:

Assign congregation rep to focus on your church's outreach Congregation Rep meets with PBCU rep to create your church's timeline Add into to church website (stock into provided by PBCU with links) Week 2: Introduce project to members (utilize video)
Designate a monthly "Foster Care" Day (2nd Sunday, 3rd Saturday, etc.)
Deploy bookmark prayer campaign
Weeks 3-4: Recruit additional Foster Care team members

Host Info Session (educational session about the need & how to get involved)
Host "Heart Gallery" poster & prayer (intro to quarterly pray-for-a-child program)
Start James 1:27 List

Celebrate impact to date; members share their stories Recruit team to spearhead "wrap-around" services Ongoing pray-for-a-child program Begin monthly service provider video (highlight various agencies to assist) Begin monthly bulletin article

Ongoing: Monthly child prayer, agency videos, bulletin articles, & impact stories

Host aged out youth or foster parent presentation Service provider fair (following presentation) Wraparound program continues & grows to assist those fostering

Month 5:

New "Heart Gallery" Poster
Host Info Session (orientation and classes if enough signups)

Congregation coordinated community outreach with Home Kits – Yard signs, info cards, for members to use as talking points; ask key members to host "coffees"

New bookmarks (semi-annual) Host a Guardian ad Litem Info Session (schedule onsite training if enough signups) Focus on a Kids Helping Kids (post flyers, make care packs, teach empathy)

Month 8:

New "Heart Gallery" Poster
Book reading: divide key members into groups; assign different book to each group

Have book reading groups give short presentation on what they learned

Strong focus on impact to date & enhancing/growing the Wraparound program Host a foster parent info session (orientation and classes if enough signups)

Month 11: New "Heart Gallery" Poster

Celebrate the impact your church family has made & commit to continuing mission!
